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Guidelines and Eligibility Criteria for **"Dr. Kalpana Srivatsava Young Scientist Award"**

Objective

The "Dr.Kalpana Srivatsava Young Scientist Award" aims to recognize and honor outstanding research contributions in the field of mental health, it has to be presented at the CPSI annual conference.

Eligibility Criteria

- Research Focus: Research should focus on positive mental health, well-being, or related topics.
- Researcher should be a member of CPSI (Life fellow/PLM/Associate members)
- Researcher should have minimum 3 years of experience in the field of Clinical Psychology.
- Abstract Submission: Submit an abstract of the research paper to the conference organizing committee.
- Presenter Eligibility: The presenter should be the primary author of the research paper & He should be a PLM or Fellow of CPSI.
- Registration: The presenter should register for the conference.

Guidelines for Submission

- Abstract Format: Submit a 250-300 word abstract in the specified format.
- Submission Deadline: Check the conference website for the abstract submission deadline.
- Full Paper: submit a copy of the full paper well in advance.

Selection Process

- Review Committee: A committee will review abstracts & full paper based on:
 - Originality and Impact: Originality and potential impact of the research.
 - Methodology and Quality: Quality of research methodology and findings.
 - Relevance: Relevance to positive mental health.
- Oral Presentation: Selected presenters will deliver an oral presentation during the conference.
- Award Winner: The winner will be selected based on the oral presentation and research quality.

Award Details

- Cash Prize: ₹5,000
- Certificate and Recognition: A certificate and recognition during the conference.

Presentation Guidelines

- Presentation Format: Oral presentation of 10-15 minutes, followed by Q&A.
- Presenters should submit the PPT compatible version & PDF of full article within the stipulated time.
